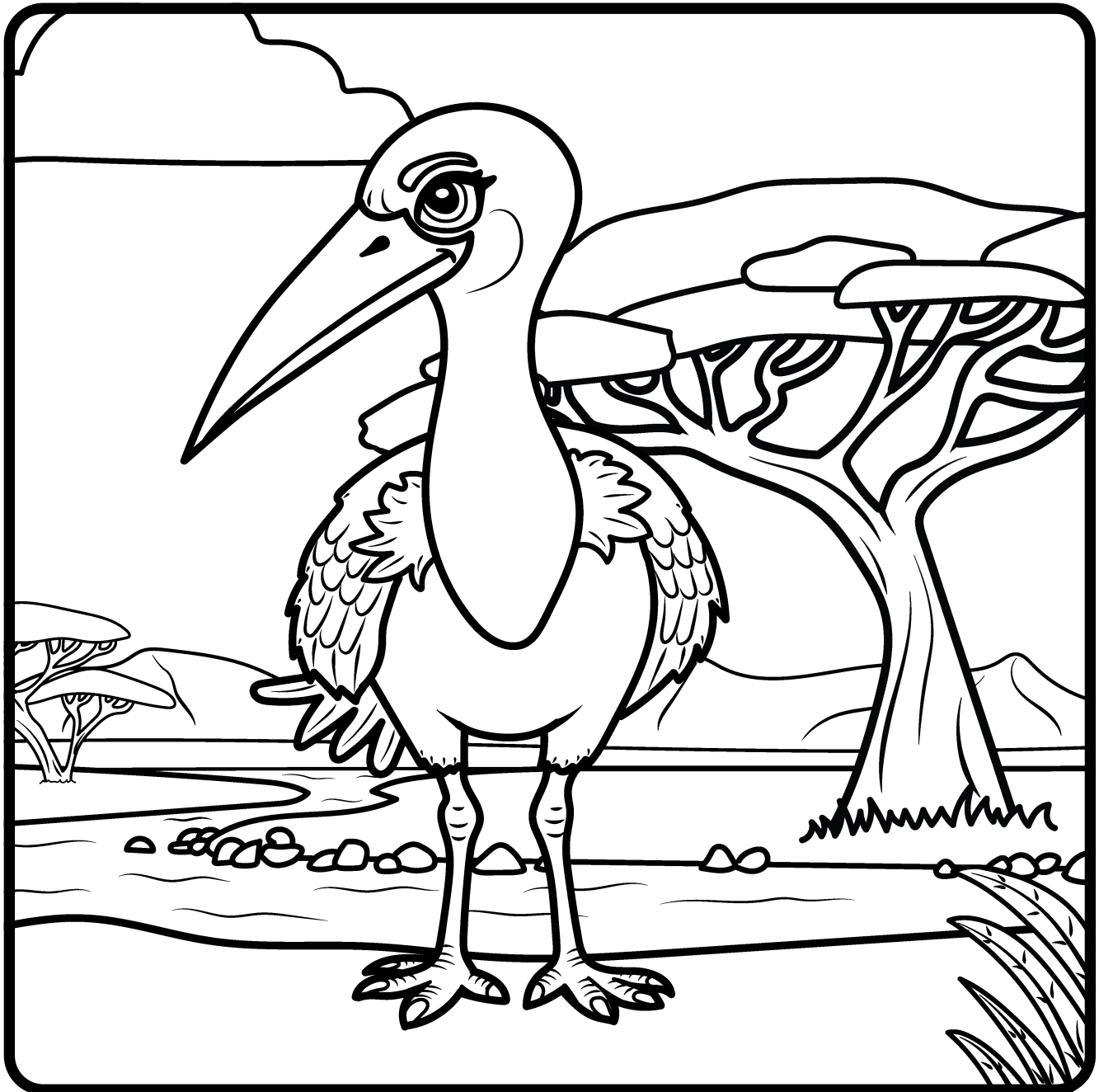
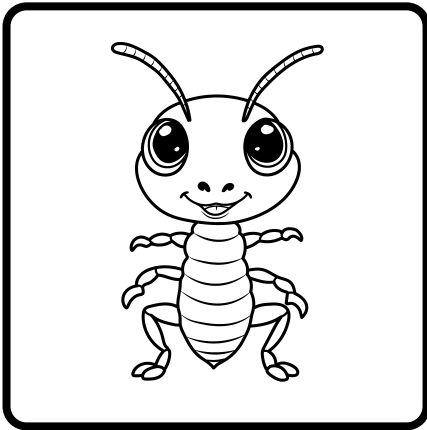


# Marabou Stork

- **Giant wingspan** - Marabou storks have one of the largest wingspans of any bird, stretching up to 10 feet from tip to tip - that's wider than a car!
- **The undertaker bird** - They are sometimes called the "undertaker birds" because of their hunched posture and dark feathers that look like they're wearing a black cloak.
- **Nature's cleanup crew** - Marabou storks are scavengers, which means they clean up the savannah by eating leftover scraps from dead animals. They have bald heads so they stay cleaner while eating their messy meals..
- **Throat pouch decoration** - They have a large pink pouch hanging from their throat that they can inflate like a balloon during mating displays or to help them cool down.
- **Sky-high flyers** - Even though they look heavy and awkward on the ground, marabou storks are excellent fliers and can soar high in the sky using warm air currents called thermals.

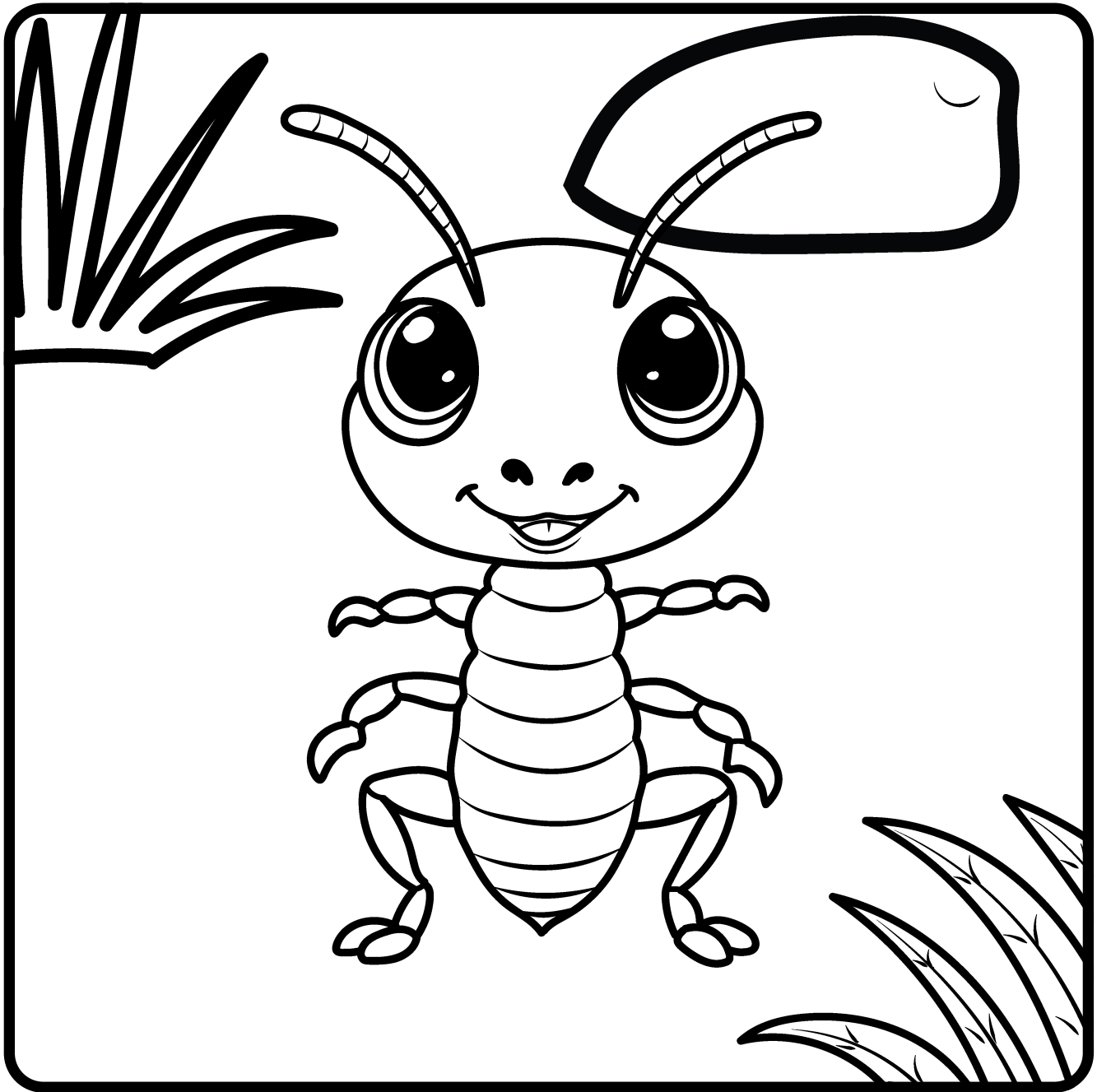


Marabou Stork

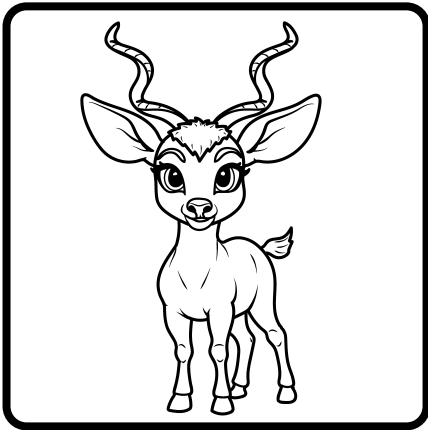


# Termites

- **Tiny architects** - Termites build massive mounds that can reach 30 feet (9 meters) tall - that's like a three-story building! If humans built proportionally, our buildings would be a mile high.
- **Air conditioning experts** - Termite mounds have a clever ventilation system with tunnels and chimneys that keeps the inside cool even when it's blazing hot outside.
- **Super strong builders** - Termites mix soil with their saliva and droppings to create a cement-like material that's so hard, it's difficult to break even with tools!
- **The queen's long life** - The termite queen can live for 20-50 years and lays thousands of eggs every single day - she's the mother of the entire colony which can be home to over 2 million termites! They all work together like one big family.
- **Farmers underground** - Some termites grow their own food! They cultivate special fungus gardens inside their mounds that they harvest and eat.

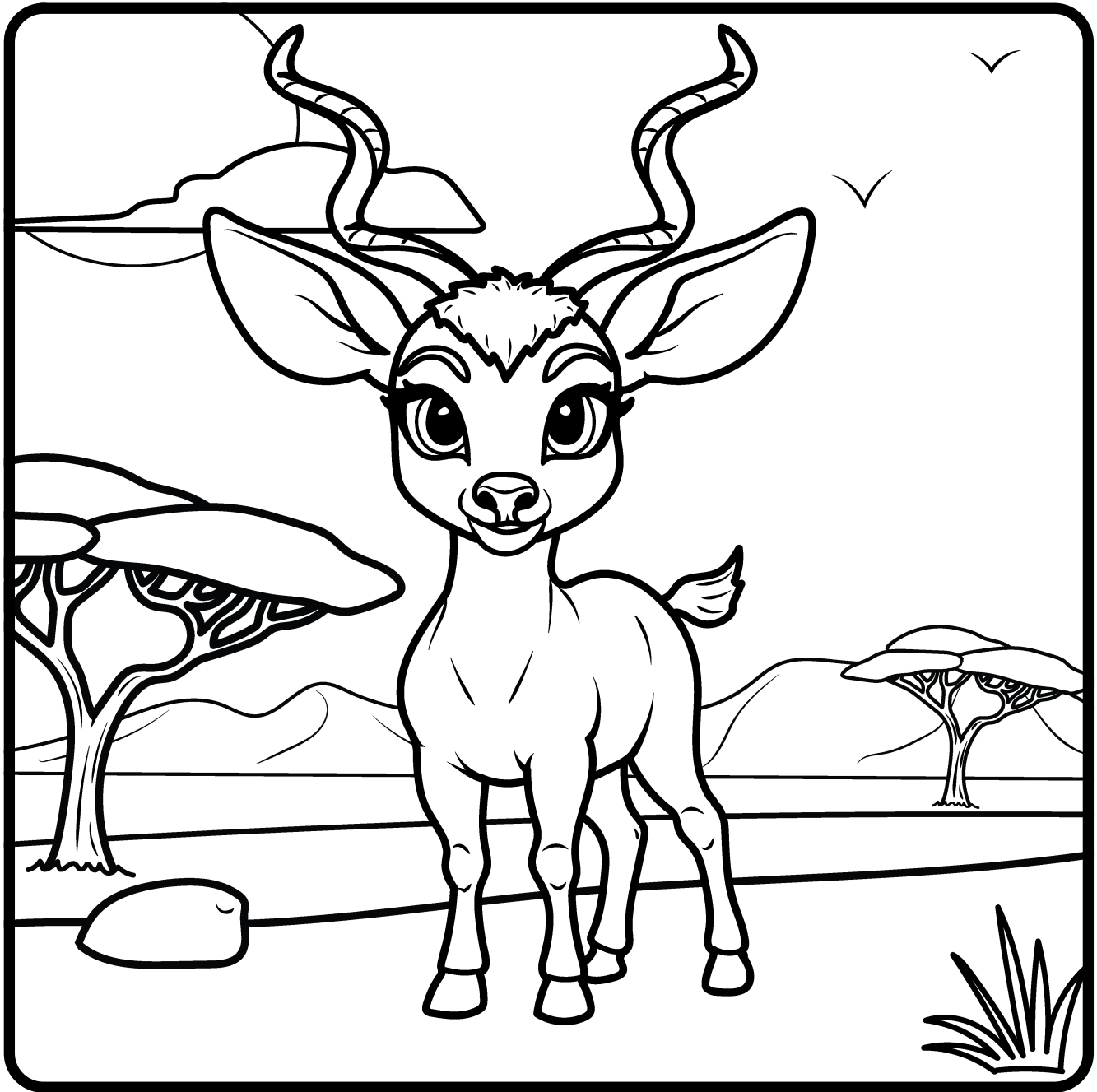

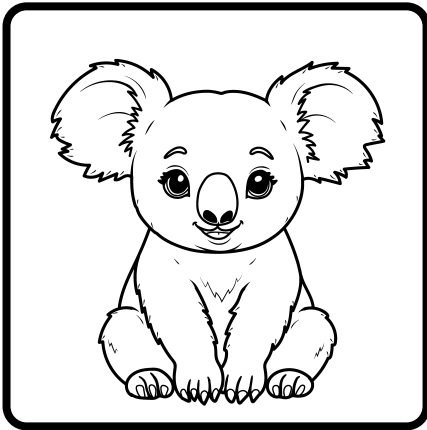


# Greater Kudu

- **Magnificent spiral horns** - Male kudus have spectacular twisted horns that spiral like corkscrews and can grow up to 6 feet (1.8 meters) long - making them some of the longest horns of any antelope!
- **High jump champions** - Despite being large animals, greater kudus can jump over 7 feet (2 meters) high - that's like jumping over a tall fence with ease!
- **Stripe camouflage** - Kudus have 6-10 white stripes running down their sides that help them blend into the light and shadows of bushes and forests, making them hard for predators to spot.
- **Ear radar** - Greater kudus have huge ears that can rotate independently, like satellite dishes, to pick up sounds from all directions and listen for danger.
- **Gentle browsers** - Kudus use their long tongues and flexible lips to carefully pluck leaves, shoots, and fruits from bushes and trees, helping to shape the landscape as they feed.

# Koala

- **Sleepyheads of the animal kingdom** - Koalas sleep 18-22 hours every day! They need all that rest because eucalyptus leaves don't give them much energy.
- **Not actually bears** - Even though people call them "koala bears," koalas aren't bears at all! They're marsupials, which means mothers carry their babies in a pouch, just like kangaroos.
- **Picky eaters** - Koalas only eat eucalyptus leaves, and they're super choosy! They have an excellent sense of smell that helps them choose the best eucalyptus leaves to eat and avoid the poisonous ones.
- **Built-in cushions** - Koalas have extra thick fur on their bottoms that works like a cushion, so they can sit comfortably in tree branches all day long!
- **Water in their name** - The word "koala" comes from an Aboriginal word meaning "no drink" because koalas get most of their water from eucalyptus leaves and rarely need to drink!

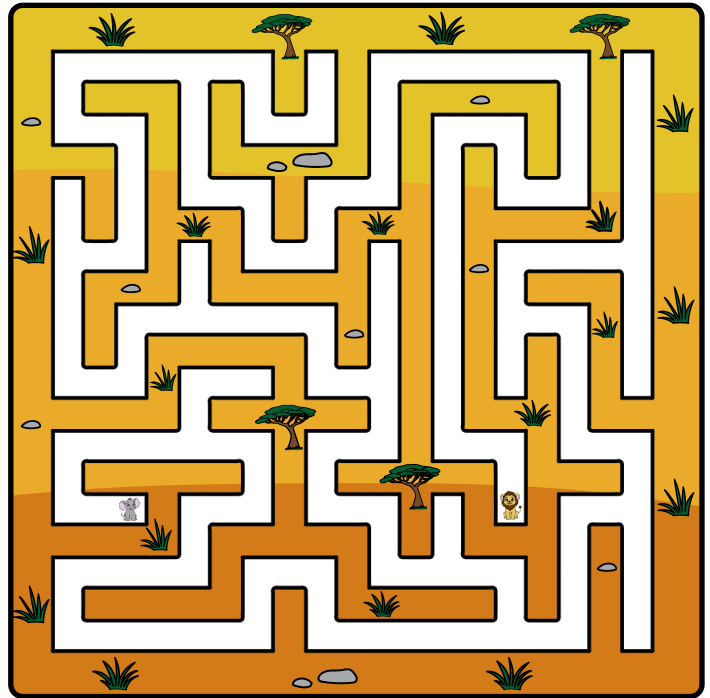

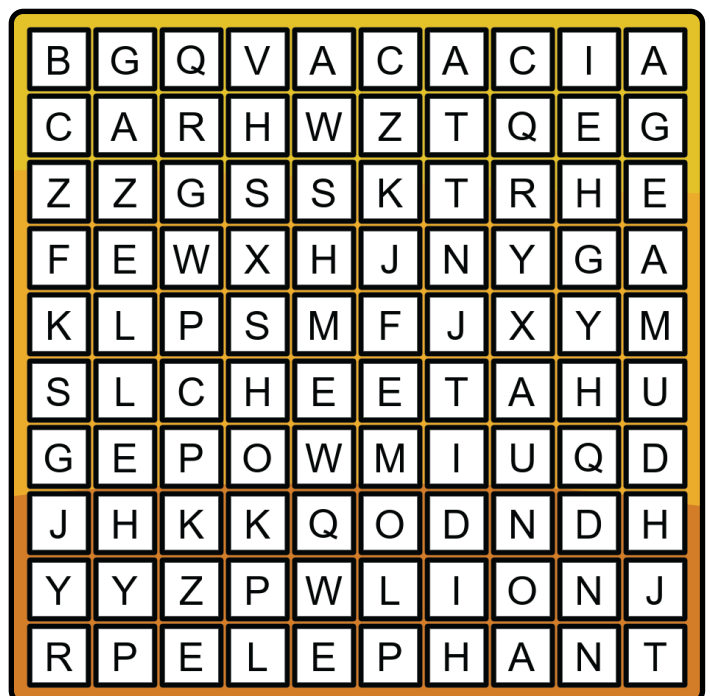

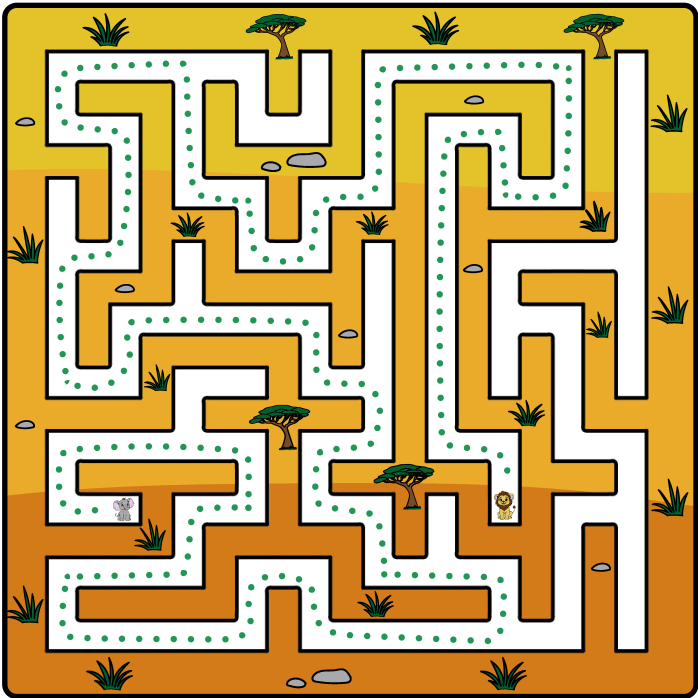
